“When Jesus... saw a large crowd, He had compassion on them ... so He began teaching them. By this time it was late in the day, so His disciples came and said, ‘This is a remote place. Send the people away so they can go and buy something to eat.’ But Jesus answered, ‘You give them something to eat!’ They said, ‘That would take eight months of a man's wages!’” Mark 6:34-37 (NIV)

### 1. I confess I have a **NEED**.

**Principle: God doesn't work in our life until we ask Him to.**

“Ask and it will be given to you ...” Matthew 7:7 (NIV)

When we have problems we tend to ...

#### **PROCRASTINATE**

“By this time it was late in the day ...”

#### **PASS THE BLAME**

“Send the people away ...”

#### **WORRY**

“That would take eight months of a man's wages ...”

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### 2. I consider what I already **HAVE**.

“‘How many loaves do you have?’ Jesus asked, ‘Go and see.’ When they found out, they said, ‘Five small loaves of bread and two fish.’” Mark 6:38 (NIV)

**Principle: God always begins with what we have.**

“You give them something to eat.” Mark 6:37 (NIV)

“Jesus asked this only to test them, for He already had in mind what He was going to do.” John 6:6 (NIV)

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### 3. I commit what I have to **GOD**.

**Principle: God uses whatever we give Him.**

“Jesus took the five loaves and the two fish... He blessed the food and broke the loaves and He kept giving them to the disciples to set before the people...” Mark 6:41 (NASB)

The boy gave what he had... willingly, cheerfully & immediately.

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### 4. I count on God to **MULTIPLY** it.

“Everyone ate and had enough. Afterwards they collected 12 baskets full of ... leftovers!” Mark 6:42-43 (Ph)

**Principle: Sowing and Reaping**

“Whatever you sow you're going to reap.” Galatians 6:7 (NIV)

“All things are possible with God.” Mark 10:27 (NIV)

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
