FIVE WAYS GOD USES PROBLEMS IN MY LIFE

1. God uses problems to point me in a new DIRECTION

“Sometimes it takes a painful experience to make us change our ways.” Proverbs 20:30 (GN)

Ask: Where is this problem LEADING me?

2. God uses problems to TEST me

“The Lord God led you all the way in the desert these 40 years . . . to test you in order to know what was in your heart . . .” Deuteronomy 8:2 (NIV)

Ask: What does this problem REVEAL about me?

“Consider it pure joy whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance . . . so you may be mature and complete. . .” James 1:2-4 (NIV)

“I (God) have tested you in the fire of suffering, as silver is refined in a furnace.” Isaiah 48:10 (GN)

3. God uses problems to TEACH me

“It was good for me to be afflicted so that I might learn Your statutes.” Psalm 119:71 (NIV)

“. . . it was the best thing that could have happened to me, for it taught me to pay attention to Your laws!” Psalm 119:71 (LB)

“Let God train you, for He is doing what any loving father does for his children. Whoever heard of a son who was never corrected?” Hebrews 12:7 (LB)

Ask: What does this problem TEACH me?

4. God uses problems to PROTECT me

“It is better, if it is God's will, to suffer for doing good, than for doing evil.” 1 Peter 3:17 (NIV)

Ask: What is being PREVENTED by this?

“You intended it to harm me, but God intended it for good.” Genesis 50:20 (NIV)

5. God uses problems to DEVELOP me

“We can rejoice when we run into problems and trials for we know that they are good for us -- they help us learn to be patient. And patience develops strength of character in us and helps us trust God more each time we use it . . .” Romans 5:3-4 (LB)

Ask: How can I GROW from this problem?
