I. The Pharisee Who FOOLED Himself

"Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank You that I am not like other men-extortionists, un-just, adulterers, or even as this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess." (vv.10-12)

- Fooled by his fasting
- Fooled by his giving
- Fooled by his praying

What impresses God is when you don't try to impress God.

II. The Person Who FAULTED Himself

"But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, 'God, have mercy on me, a sinner." (v.13)

Humility impresses God...

- His eyes
- His hands
- His voice

Honesty impresses God.

III. The Principle That FULFILLS Itself

"I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be abased, and he who humbles himself will be exalted." (v.14)

- It is not how you see you, but how God sees you that matters.
- When you see God the way you should see God, then you will see you the way you really are.
- Mercy is not what God pays you because you tell Him you have earned it. It is what God gives you when you admit to Him that you need it.
